**IFLA Europe and Romanian Landscape Architects Association – ASOP (Asociatia Peisagistilor din Romania) have been selected as official Partner of the EU Green Week 2019!** The event focused on the legislation as a determinant for the quality of the environment in which we live today and is developed in partnership with the [International Federation of Landscape Architects - European Region](#) and the [University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine Bucharest](#). The activities embedded by this conference aimed to identify examples of good practice as well as specific problems regarding the creation of a regulatory framework that can favour the development of green infrastructures by involving citizens in the law-making process. On the **Day 1, Monday, 13 May 2019**, the Urban Arboriculture workshop was organised including a practical demonstration – maintenance for trees. On **Day 2, 14 May 2019**, an international panel of experts presented international and national practices for Green Infrastructure and the speakers included: Ellen Fetzer, President of ECLAS (European Council of Landscape Schools), Adrian Ilie, EMBA – Entrepreneur, Partner at Synergetics Corporation, Consultant for Regional Development and Smart City Smart Technologies, Jeroen de Vries, Advisory Board member of the DG Groep, Director Researcher of the LE:NOTRE Institute, Member of The Netherlands Association for Landscape Architecture (NVTL) and Eugen Pănescu, Planwerk, member of the Executive Council of the ACE (European Architects' Council). **Day 3, 15 May 2019**, was opened by Ciprian Lucian Roșca, State Secretary within the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Administration and by Florin Stănică, Pro-Rector for Students and International Relations within the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine Bucharest. The discussion on the Romanian legislation and the vision on strategic development focused on the national regulatory framework: Urbanism Code and the vision on sustainable urban development; Revision of Law no. 24/2007 of green spaces and urban green systems; Heritage Code and landscape issues and the Territorial Development Strategy for Romania and landscape issues. On **Day 4, 16 May 2019**, a roundtable was organised aimed to set up a working group that will further develop specific norms that can support green infrastructures development at national level in the broader context of the European Union. AsoP Romania 2019 Conference closed with the opening of the IFLA Europe exhibition which aims to highlights a number of landscaping projects from all over Europe. **German Landscape Architecture Prize 2019 has been decided.** The first prize goes to Baakenpark - a place of longing in eastern HafenCity, Hamburg, designed by Atelier Loidl Landschaftsarchitekten, Berlin. This was decided by the jury on 12 April 2019 in Berlin. Since 2015, an artificial peninsula made of Elbsand has formed the green centre of the eastern Hafen city in the Elbe metropolis. The spectacular topography with its wild tree population creates a variety of spaces. Where public life is increasingly shifting into open space, various spaces for a wide variety of uses are offered in a concentrated and well zoned manner. At their meeting in the German Architecture Centre, the eleven judges appointed by the BDLA under the direction of the jury chairmen Prof. Inga Hahn, Hahn Hertling von Hantelmann, Hamburg/Berlin, examined the 35 nominated works, awarded first prize and prizes in nine categories.
